Beginning at a + on a stone at the West corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 39 and on the South side of Kou Road, from which a + on a stone at the South corner of Kou and Kamane Roads is by true azimuth and distance $75^{\circ} 52' 100.0$ feet, Trig. Station "Kikoo" is by true azimuth $106^{\circ} 28' 30''$ and the Church Spire is $51^{\circ} 43'$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2464, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $255^{\circ} 52'$ 100.0 feet along Kou Road to + on stone;
2. $345^{\circ} 52'$ 150.0 feet along Lot 41 to + on stone;
3. $75^{\circ} 52'$ 100.0 feet along Lot 54 to + on stone;
4. $165^{\circ} 52'$ 150.0 feet along Lot 39 to the point of beginning.
