Beginning at a pipe set in concrete, at the Northwest corner of this lot, on the East side of the Valley Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Transit of Venus" being 6557.5 feet North and 3394.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2598, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 273° 00' 520.0 feet along Lot 41, Government Remnants, and L.C.A. 10092, to Mikolouka;
2. 20° 30' 70.0 feet along West bank of Waimea River;
3. 91° 10' 485.0 feet along L.C.A. 9186, to Keauaunui;
4. 173° 10' 83.0 feet along the East side of the Valley Road to the point of beginning.
