Beginning at a + cut on stone at the <sup>Northeast</sup> corner of this lot and at the South junction of 20 and 30 foot roads, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puuike" being 4311.1 feet North and 3402.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2547, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 10' 198.3 feet along West side of road to a + cut on stone under pile of stones;
2. 7° 22' 339.9 feet along road to a + cut on pahoehoe;
3. 86° 05' 255.0 feet along Grant 2546 apana 2 to Kamaka to a + cut on stone;
4. 43° 52' 213.2 feet along Grant 2546 apana 2 to Kamaka to a + on solid rock;
5. 92° 27' 214.8 feet along Grant 2939 to Kauimakaole to a + cut on solid rock near the West edge of stream;
6. 96° 40' 204.0 feet along Grant 2939 to Kauimakaole to a + cut on stone;
7. 198° 52' 600.0 feet along Lot 39 to a + cut on stone under pile of stones;
8. 271° 24' 331.7 feet along road to a + cut on stone under pile of stones;
9. 250° 33' 340.1 feet along road to the point of beginning.
