Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot, and the Northeast corner of Lot 44, on the West side of Upper Kalopa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalanial" being 380.6 feet North and 3240.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $110^{\circ} 00'$ 937.7 feet along Lot 44 to a pipe on top of East edge of Keahua Gulch;
2. $197^{\circ} 28'$ 403.1 feet along top of East edge of Keahua Gulch to a pipe;
3. $182^{\circ} 10'$ 225.5 feet along same to a pipe;
4. $167^{\circ} 29'$ 128.2 feet along same to a pipe;
5. $203^{\circ} 03'$ 163.1 feet along same to a pipe;
6. $286^{\circ} 20'$ 860.8 feet along Lot 42 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
7. $16^{\circ} 20'$ 660.8 feet along West side of Upper Kalopa Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
8. $347^{\circ} 02'$ 338.0 feet along same to the point of beginning.
