Beginning at a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the North-west corner of this lot the East corner of Lot 45 and on the South side of 30 foot Homestead Road, the co-ordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 118.4 feet North and 1023.2 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 250° 45' 50.0 feet along Homestead Road;
2. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 262.2 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being:- 337° 50' 361.0 feet to a point on the tangent;
3. 21° 20' 86.0 feet running parallel to Hilo Railroad track;
4. 111° 20' 286.4 feet along Lots 32, 33, and 34 to a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 201° 20' 315.3 feet along Lot 45 to the point of beginning.
