Beginning at an iron rail at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 45 and on the South side of Mountain Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaaku" being ^{13424.3}~~13423.6~~ feet North and ^{1011.4}~~999.5~~ feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. ²⁵⁷⁴~~2362~~, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 229° 08' 694.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
2. 240° 15' 40.0 feet along Mountain Road to an iron rail;
3. 328° 00' 1040.0 feet along Lot 43 to an iron rail 10 feet from the edge of the Kaahakini Stream;
4. Along a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the Kaahakini Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being 75° 12' 759.6 feet to an iron rail;
5. 148° 00' 710.0 feet along Lot 45 to the point of beginning.
