Station "Nonou" is by true azimuth $338^{\circ} 14' 30''$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2449, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $257^{\circ} 44'$ 665.1 feet along Forest Reserve to + on stone;
2. $8^{\circ} 14'$ 1713.1 feet along Lot 47 to + on stone;
3. $84^{\circ} 58'$ 444.7 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
4. $181^{\circ} 23'$ 1593.5 feet along Lot 46 to the point of beginning.
