Beginning at a + on stone surrounded by three stones at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 48 and on the boundary of the Forest Reserve, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Piliamoo" is by true azimuth and distance $120^{\circ} 28'$ 384.6 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2440, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $10^{\circ} 27'$ 1438.2 feet along Lot 48 to + on stone on the North side of road;
2. $105^{\circ} 08'$ 261.0 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
3. $96^{\circ} 15'$ 296.2 feet along Kahuna Road to + on stone;
4. $188^{\circ} 14'$ 1713.1 feet along Lot 46 to + on stone;
5. $308^{\circ} 45'$ 296.2 feet along Forest Reserve to Trig. Station "Piliamoo" (marked by $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe);
6. $300^{\circ} 28'$ 384.6 feet along the Forest Reserve to the point of beginning.
