Beginning at an iron rail at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 46 and on the South side of Mountain Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being ^{12871.8}~~12871.1~~ feet North and ^{2641.9}~~2630.0~~ feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. ²⁵⁷⁴~~2382~~, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 328° 00' 1450.0 feet along Lot 46 to an iron rail 10 feet from the edge of the Kaahakini Stream;
2. Along a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the Kaahakini Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being 44° 12' 452.0 feet to an iron rail;
3. 148° 00' 1588.0 feet along Lot 48 to an iron rail; on the South side of Mountain Road;
4. 241° 55' 440.0 feet along Mountain Road to the point of beginning.
