Beginning at a Δ at the West corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 49, and on the North side of a 30 foot road, as shown on Homestead Map No. 13, on file in the office of the Survey Department, and running by true bearings:-

1. N. 30° 40' E. 1906.0 feet along Lot 49, to a stone marked Δ ;
2. S. 60° 02' E. 215.5 feet along Kealahou 3 and 4, to a rock marked + by Monsarrat, at a place called "Kaluapalolo", the same point being the extreme makai point of Kealahou 1 and 2;
3. S. 35° 47' E: 284.0 feet along Kealahou 1 and 2;
4. S. 30° 40' W. 1699.0 feet along 30 foot road reservation;
5. N. 70° 48' W. 485.5 feet along the North side of a 30 foot road, to the point of beginning.
