Beginning at a + cut on stone at the South corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 47 and on the West side of 20 foot road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puuiki" being 4793.2 feet North and 638.2 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2547, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 214° 48' 30" 181.9 feet along road to a + cut on stone near the edge of the Kapi'a Stream;
2. 115° 16' 470.3 feet along near the edge of Kapi'a Stream to a + cut on stone;
3. 95° 15' 357.2 feet along near the edge of Kapi'a Stream to a + cut on solid rock;
4. 77° 02' 662.0 feet along near the edge of Kapi'a Stream to a + cut on pahoehoe;
5. 102° 10' 592.5 feet along near the edge of Kapi'a Stream to a + cut on solid rock;
6. 5° 04' 336.3 feet along Lot 45 to a + cut on solid rock;
7. 271° 28' 387.6 feet along ridge along Lot 47 to a + cut on pahoehoe;
8. 258° 58' 605.7 feet along ridge along Lot 47 to a + cut on solid rock;
9. 277° 48' 30" 958.0 feet along ridge along Lot 47 to the point of beginning.
