Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 48, and on the East side of Haakoa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 3871.8 feet South and 328.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 311° 15' 733.5 feet along Lot 48 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 341° 36' 233.7 feet along top of West edge of Ahoa gulch;
3. 331° 41' 134.5 feet along top of West edge of Ahoa gulch;
4. 29° 42' 288.2 feet along top of West edge of Ahoa gulch;
5. 47° 26' 229.5 feet along top of West edge of Ahoa gulch;
6. 131° 15' 1161.0 feet along Lot 50 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
7. 259° 12' 213.9 feet along East side of Haakoa Road;
8. 237° 45' 184.4 feet along East side of Haakoa Road;
9. 220° 29' 183.3 feet along East side of Haakoa Road;
10. 183° 15' 186.2 feet along East side of Haakoa Road to the point of beginning.
