5. 346° 00' 197.0 feet along same to the North boundary of Grant 1150 to Kekaua;
6. 85° 30' 404.0 feet along North boundary of Grant 1150 to Kekaua, to near East bank of the Hanapepe River;
7. 188° 20' 98.0 feet along near East bank of Hanapepe River;
8. 164° 50' 92.0 feet along same;
9. 149° 00' 240.0 feet along same;
10. 204° 26' 505.3 feet along government land and L.C.A. 10678 Apana 1 to Pua, and Lot 50 to the point of beginning.
