Revised Description.

Lot 50.

Manowaiopae Homesteads,
North Hilo, Hawaii

Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 51, and on the Eastside of a 30 foot Homestead road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 8644.5 feet South and 4449.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 32° 17' 465.5 feet along near the West edge of Hokuwaikahe Gulch to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 114° 35' 815.2 feet along Lot 21, Laupahoehoe Homesteads to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 224° 50' 543.1 feet along near the East edge of Manowaiopae Gulch to an iron pipe;
4. 298° 35' 691.3 feet along Lot 52 and end of road to the point of beginning.

Area 8-41/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom all that piece or parcel of land varying from ten to forty feet in width, which variation is governed by the contour of said land so that sufficient width shall be allowed to provide for the construction and maintenance of a cane flume not exceeding 4 feet in width with necessary trestle work to support the same, said right-of-way crossing the Southwestern portion of this lot and containing an area of 20/100 acre, a little more or less.
