Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot and the South corner of Lot 52, on the Northwest side of Kalaniai Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 4062.9 feet South and 4037.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $35^{\circ} 00'$ 853.0 feet along the Northwest side of Kalaniai Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $119^{\circ} 14'$ 906.8 feet to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $215^{\circ} 00'$ 944.0 feet along Lots 49 and 51 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $305^{\circ} 00'$ 902.2 feet along Lot 52 to the point of beginning.
