Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, on the North boundary of Lot 51, and the East side of Haakoa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 4861.2 feet South and 451.5 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 202° 37' 45.5 feet along East side of Haakoa Road;
2. 174° 46' 214.0 feet along East side of Haakoa Road;
3. 202° 41' 278.8 feet along East side of Haakoa Road;
4. 266° 15' 160.7 feet along East side of Haakoa Road;
5. 259° 12' 25.3 feet along East side of Haakoa Road;
6. 311° 15' 1161.0 feet along Lot 49 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
7. 58° 49' 177.8 feet along top of West edge of Ahoa gulch;
8. 63° 50' 277.5 feet along top of West edge of Ahoa gulch;
9. 26° 39' 168.0 feet along top of West edge of Ahoa gulch to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
10. 131° 15' 914.1 feet along Lot 51 to the point of beginning.
