Beginning at a + on stone at the ^{Southwest} corner of Lot 50 and on the North side of Government Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papapaholahola" are 5770.5 feet South and 2280.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2378, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 180° 00' 316.3 feet along Lot 50 to a + on stone;
2. 270° 00' 488.6 feet along Lot 52 to a + on stone;
3. 335° 46' 217.6 feet along L.C.A. 3395B, apana 1 to Keona to a red-wood post;
4. 60° 45' 12.2 feet along Lot 84 to a red-wood post;
5. 84° 19' 164.8 feet along L.C.A. 8840 to Kanenehakuole to a red-wood post;
6. 3° 19' 381.4 feet along L.C.A. 8840 to Kanenehakuole and Lot 83 to a + on stone at Government Road;

Thence along the Government Road, the direct azimuths and distances being:-

7. 125° 14' 221.9 feet to a + on stone;
8. 83° 41' 130.6 feet to a + on stone;
9. 118° 15' 62.0 feet to a + on stone;
10. 173° 11' 146.0 feet to the point of beginning.
