Beginning at the East corner of this lot on the boundary between the lands of Koula and Kahunaone, and on the Northwest side of a 15 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puolo" being 22586.0 feet North and 18485.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2620, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 30° 15' 291.2 feet along stonewall on West side of 15 foot road to junction of 20 foot road;
2. 93° 10' 86.0 feet along stonewall on North side of 20 foot road;
3. 124° 00' 247.0 feet along same to East side of ditch near bank of Hanapepe River;
4. 234° 50' 188.0 feet along East side of ditch near bank of Hanapepe River;
5. 241° 50' 194.0 feet along near the East bank of Hanapepe River to boundary of Grant 1108 to Paniani;
6. 309° 00' 145.0 feet along South boundary of Grant 1108 to Paniani to the point of beginning.
