Beginning at an iron rail at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Mountain Road and the land of Hakalau Nui, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being ^{12025.0}~~12024.4~~ feet North and ^{4210.9}~~4199.9~~ feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No; ^{2574,}~~2382,~~ and running by true azimuths:-

1. 328° 00' 1180.0 feet along Mountain Road and along Lot 50 to an iron rail 10 feet from the edge of the Kaahakini Stream;
2. Along a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the Kaahakini Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being 93° 18' 1088.7 feet to an iron pipe;
3. 189° 35' 737.0 feet along the land of Hakalau Nui to a + on stone;
4. 237° 55' 400.0 feet along the land of Hakalau Nui to the point of beginning.
