Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe on the North boundary of this lot, the West corner of Lot 50, and the East side of Haakoa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 4861.2 feet South and 451.5 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 311° 15' 914.1 feet along Lot 50 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 55° 00' 181.5 feet along top of West edge of Ahoa gulch;
3. 101° 22' 93.6 feet along top of West edge of Ahoa gulch;
4. 34° 54' 481.6 feet along top of West edge of Ahoa gulch;
5. 118° 31' 690.6 feet along Grant 4286 to F.M. Swanzy to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 227° 15' 180.2 feet along top of East edge of Haakoa gulch;
7. 240° 00' 72.6 feet along top of East edge of Haakoa gulch;
8. 200° 53' 156.6 feet along top of East edge of Haakoa gulch;
9. 180° 37' 160.6 feet along top of East edge of Haakoa gulch;
10. 197° 59' 170.8 feet along top of East edge of Haakoa gulch;
11. 219° 34' 126.2 feet along top of East edge of Haakoa gulch;
12. 202° 37' 55.8 feet along top of East edge of Haakoa gulch;
13. 311° 15' 36.7 feet across Haakoa Road to the point of beginning.
