
Portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Hanapepe

Beginning at an iron pin at the northwest corner of this lot, on the east boundary of L.C.Aw. 8077 Apana 4 to Hii and on the south side of Hanapepe Valley Road, 30 feet wide, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "PUOLO" being 9676.20 feet North and 11101.50 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2616, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:--

1. $257^{\circ} 03' 30''$ 124.90 feet along the south side of Hanapepe Valley Road to an iron pin;
2. Thence along same on a curve to the right having a radius of 65.00 feet the chord azimuth and distance being $273^{\circ} 20' 30''$ 36.45 feet to an iron pin;
3. $289^{\circ} 37' 30''$ 40.00 feet along the south side of Hanapepe Valley Road to an iron pin;
4. Thence along the north bank of auwai "KUHUMU" the direct azimuth and distance being $69^{\circ} 14'$ 192.40 feet;
5. $164^{\circ} 05'$ 58.00 feet along L.C.Aw. 8077 Apana 4 to Hii to the point of beginning and passing over a pipe in concrete at 7.55 feet.
