1. 10° 04' 229.7 feet along homestead road to a red-wood post;
2. 84° 03' 99.0 feet along L.C.A. 8044:2 to Alauka to + on stone;
3. 35° 33' 256.0 feet along L.C.A. 8044:2 to Alauka to + on stone;
4. 335° 46' 113.9 feet along L.C.A. 3395B:1 to Keoua to red-wood post;
5. 90° 00' 488.6 feet along Lot 51 to + on stone;
6. 180° 00' 548.1 feet along Lot 50 to + on stone;
7. 270° 00' 729.3 feet along Lot 53 crossing gulch and over ridge to the point of beginning.
