Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe at the South corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 50, on the Northwest side of Kalaniai Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 4062.9 feet South and 4037.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $125^{\circ} 00'$  902.2 feet along Lot 50 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
2.  $215^{\circ} 00'$  940.0 feet along Lots 51 and 53 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
3.  $305^{\circ} 00'$  1051.0 feet along Lots 55 and 56 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
4.  $62^{\circ} 00'$  718.3 feet along the Northwest side of Kalaniai Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
5.  $360^{\circ} 00'$  309.1 feet along the West side of Kalaniai Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
6.  $35^{\circ} 00'$  46.8 feet along the Northwest side of Kalaniai Road to the point of beginning.
