Beginning at a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North boundary of this lot, the South corner of Lot 53, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 5068.4 feet South and 797.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:

1. $311^{\circ} 15'$ 31.7 feet across Kaiwilahilahi Road;
2. $43^{\circ} 17'$ 210.0 feet along top of West edge of Haakoa gulch;
3. $17^{\circ} 20'$ 96.7 feet along top of West edge of Haakoa gulch;
4. $55^{\circ} 56'$ 169.0 feet along top of West edge of Haakoa gulch;
5. $4^{\circ} 38'$ 80.6 feet along top of West edge of Haakoa gulch to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. $118^{\circ} 31'$ 1253.1 feet along Grant 4287 to Geo. H. Angus, to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
7. $229^{\circ} 01'$ 72.3 feet along top of East edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
8. $241^{\circ} 01'$ 189.5 feet along top of East edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
9. $215^{\circ} 11'$ 336.0 feet along top of East edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
10. $208^{\circ} 16'$ 224.1 feet along top of East edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe.
11. $311^{\circ} 15'$ 1165.9 feet along Lot 53 to the point of beginning.
