Beginning at $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 54 and at the end of the Akulikuli Road, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" is by true azimuth $345^{\circ} 45'$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2449, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $344^{\circ} 27'$ 656.3 feet along Lot 54 to + on stone;
2. $351^{\circ} 50'$ 460.1 feet along Lot 54 to + on stone;
3. $119^{\circ} 47'$ 109.9 feet along top of pali to + on stone;
4. $120^{\circ} 43'$ 96.9 feet along top of pali to + on stone;
5. $83^{\circ} 03'$ 96.9 feet along top of pali to + on stone;
6. $53^{\circ} 11'$ 449.9 feet down pali and along the bank of the Kapaa Stream to + on rock;
7. $32^{\circ} 50'$ 275.5 feet along the Kahuna Road to + on stone;
8. $169^{\circ} 11'$ 1250.3 feet along Lot 48 to + on stone;
9. $248^{\circ} 21'$ 350.5 feet along Forest Reserve to + on stone;
10. $295^{\circ} 28'$ 137.8 feet along Forest Reserve to + on stone;
11. $238^{\circ} 47'$ 382.2 feet along Forest Reserve to the point of beginning.
