Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 54, on the Southeast side of Upper Kalopa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 2524.0 feet South and 5160.7 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $305^{\circ} 00'$ 1126.4 feet along Lots 54 and 55 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $35^{\circ} 00'$ 698.0 feet along Lot 52 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $125^{\circ} 00'$ 1375.5 feet along Lot 51 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $253^{\circ} 55'$ 426.5 feet along Southeast side of Upper Kalopa Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
5. $212^{\circ} 03'$ 366.5 feet along the Southeast side of Upper Kalopa Road to the point of beginning.
