Station "Papapaholahola" is by true azimuth and distance  $156^{\circ} 03' 30''$  4964.1 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2378, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $151^{\circ} 58'$  241.8 feet along ridge along Lot 49 to a + on stone;
2.  $175^{\circ} 16'$  250.8 feet along ridge along Lot 49 to a + on stone;
3.  $270^{\circ} 00'$  1289.0 feet along Lots 46 and 55 to a + on stone;
4.  $354^{\circ} 55'$  378.3 feet along road to a + on stone;
5.  $84^{\circ} 55'$  41.4 feet along 20 foot right of way to a red-wood post
6.  $146^{\circ} 09'$  217.8 feet along L.C.A. 3395B:1 to Keoua to a red-wood post;
7.  $34^{\circ} 09'$  264.0 feet along L.C.A. 3395B:1 to Keoua to a red-wood post;
8.  $69^{\circ} 36'$  129.3 feet along Lot 53 to a + on stone at top of small knoll;
9.  $90^{\circ} 00'$  756.6 feet along Lot 53 crossing a gulch and a second one coming in from the North at an angle to the point of beginning.
