Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot at the South corner of Upper Kalopa Road, and Cross Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 1470.5 feet South and 4613.8 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $305^{\circ} 00'$ 979.6 feet along the South side of Cross Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $35^{\circ} 00'$ 1176.5 feet along Lot 55 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $125^{\circ} 00'$ 823.2 feet along Lot 53 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $260^{\circ} 00'$ 417.5 feet along the South side of Upper Kalopa Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
5. $204^{\circ} 00'$ 273.0 feet along the East side of Upper Kalopa Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
6. $170^{\circ} 00'$ 376.6 feet along the East side of Upper Kalopa Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
7. $200^{\circ} 00'$ 262.2 feet along same to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
8. $180^{\circ} 00'$ 114.5 feet along same to the point of beginning.
