Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanised iron pipe at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 53, and on the West side of Kaiwilahilahi Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 4412.2 feet South and 644.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 131° 15' 957.5 feet along Lot 53 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 182° 33' 112.6 feet along East edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
3. 210° 10' 122.2 feet along East edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
4. 221° 04' 426.3 feet along East edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 311° 15' 1229.0 feet along Lot 55 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 51° 26' 67.1 feet along West side of Kaiwilahilahi Road;
7. 90° 42' 283.7 feet along West side of Kaiwilahilahi Road;
8. 54° 36' 170.3 feet along West side of Kaiwilahilahi Road;
9. 24° 57' 90.8 feet along West side of Kaiwilahilahi Road;
10. 14° 46' 145.8 feet along West side of Kaiwilahilahi Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe.
