Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 56, on the South side of Cross Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalanial" being 2438.5 feet South and 3231.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $35^{\circ} 00'$ 1176.5 feet along Lot 56 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $125^{\circ} 00'$ 708.0 feet along Lots 52 and 53 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $215^{\circ} 00'$ 1176.5 feet along Lot 54 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $305^{\circ} 00'$ 708.0 feet along the South side of Cross Road to the point of beginning.
