Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 56, and on the West side of Kaiwilahilahi Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 3602.9 feet South and 185.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 41° 27' 144.0 feet along West side of Kaiwilahilahi Road;
2. 12° 27' 240.5 feet along West side of Kaiwilahilahi Road;
3. 51° 26' 170.5 feet along West side of Kaiwilahilahi Road;
4. 131° 15' 1229.0 feet along Lot 54 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 204° 37' 170.2 feet along East edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
6. 239° 13' 378.0 feet along East edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
7. 311° 15' 1075.3 feet along Lot 56 to the point of beginning.
