Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 55, on the South side of Cross Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalanial" being 2438.5 feet South and 3231.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 305° 00' 400.0 feet along the South side of Cross Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. 35° 00' 79.0 feet along Northwest side of Kalanial Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. 331° 00' 371.3 feet along West side of Kalanial Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. 15° 00' 189.9 feet along West side of Kalanial Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
5. 34° 00' 441.5 feet along Northwest side of Kalanial Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
6. 62° 00' 352.7 feet along Northwest side of Kalanial Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
7. 125° 00' 646.2 feet along Lot 52 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
8. 215° 00' 1176.5 feet along Lot 55 to the point of beginning.
