1. 32° 40' 264.0 feet along L.C.A. 10688, to Pahunui;
2. 127° 40' 696.0 feet along L.C.A. 9227, to Kaawa; thence
3. Along the foot of the pali to the point of beginning, the direct azimuths and distances being:
