Beginning at a mamane post at the West corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 58 on the East side of Kula road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Kali" being: 5215.2 feet South and 13418.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:

1. 227° 30' 38.0 feet along Kula road to a mamane post;
2. 213° 16' 472.0 feet along Kula road to a mamane post;
3. 179° 45' 252.3 feet along Kula road to a mamane post;
4. 309° 46' 1356.0 feet along Lot 56 to a mamane post;
5. 38° 20' 700.2 feet along Lot 46 to a mamane post;
6. 129° 46' 1163.0 feet along Lot 58 to the point of beginning.
