Beginning at an iron rail at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 18, in Haiku Gulch, the coordinates of said iron rail referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauhikoa" being ^{1634.0}~~1633.5~~ feet North and ^{1399.6}~~1378.2~~ feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2542, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 260° 05' 450.0 feet along Lot 18; Kuiaha-Pauwela Homesteads;
2. 274° ^{00'}~~20'~~ ^{952.0}~~965.0~~ feet along Lot 18; Kuiaha-Pauwela Homesteads;
3. 8° 20' ^{791.0}~~792.8~~ feet along Pauwela Road;
4. 69° 23' 1498.0 feet along Lot 58 to an iron rail in Haiku Gulch;
5. Thence along the Haiku Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being ~~184° 55' 1312.0~~ feet to the point of beginning. ^{185° 26'} ^{1305.0}
