Beginning at a mamane post at the West corner of this lot, and the North corner of Lot 59, on the East side of Kula road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Kali" being 5752.0 feet South and 12969.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 263° 23' 69.0 feet along Kula road to a mamane post;
2. 203° 24' 200.0 feet along same; to a mamane post;
3. 208° 56' 159.0 feet along same; to a mamane post;
4. 227° 30' 264.6 feet along Kula road;
5. 309° 46' 1170.1 feet along the South side of a 40 foot road reserve;
6. 38° 20' 660.2 feet along Lot 47, to a mamane post;
7. 129° 46' 1183.0 feet along Lot 59, to the point of beginning.
