Beginning at a pipe set in concrete at base of post marking the **E a s t** corner of this piece, on the West side of the Waimea River, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Transit of Venus" being 8527.8 feet North and 2397.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2599, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 47° 20' 100.0 feet to foot of pali; thence
2. Along the foot of pali, the direct azimuths and distances being:

115° 00'	314.0 feet;
131° 45'	292.0 feet;
182° 50'	50.0 feet;
134° 00'	275.0 feet;
52° 30'	65.0 feet;
118° 00'	478.0 feet;

3. 260° 30' 290.0 feet to West bank of the Waimea River; thence

4. Along the West side of the Waimea River to the point of beginning, the direct azimuths and distances being:

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way six (6) feet wide for the ditch across this lot, said right-of-way containing an area of 15/100 acre; Also, excepting and reserving therefrom L.C.A. 6379, to Kauailahalaha, containing an area of 15/100 acre, together with an easement right from said L.C.A. to the main government road, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 4-16/100 ACRES.
