Beginning at an iron rail at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 57 and on the West side of Pauwela Road, the coordinates of said iron rail referred to Government Survey Trig Station "Kauhikoa" being ~~826.7~~^{862.6} feet North and ~~2668.8~~^{2678.0} feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2542, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 339° 45' 358.3 feet along Pauwela Road;
2. 332° 52' 483.5 feet along Pauwela Road;
3. 41° 50' 228.5 feet along Pauwela Road;
4. 23° 31' ~~205.9~~^{216.5} feet along Pauwela Road; 10 ft. west of an iron rail;
5. 71° 55' ~~1314.0~~^{1319.0} feet along Grant 2701 to D. Crowningberg to Haiku Gulch;
6. Thence down along the Haiku Gulch to the Southwest corner of Lot 57, the direct azimuth and distance being ~~165° 21' 1041.0~~^{165° 59' 1042.0} feet;
7. 249° 23' 1498.0 feet along Lot 57 to the point of beginning.

Area 35-93/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 40 feet wide across this lot for the Maui Agr. Co. Kauhikoa ditch.

Excepting and reserving Haiku Stream and all riparian and other rights in or to this stream and the waters thereof.
