Beginning at a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot the North corner of Lot 57 and on the East side of a 30 foot Homestead Road, the co-ordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 4405.8 feet South and 3507.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 218° 23' 114.0 feet along East side of Homestead Road;
2. 254° 50' 53.0 feet along South side of Homestead Road;
3. 293° 31' 298.3 feet along South side of Homestead Road;
4. 245° 18' 130.6 feet along South side of Homestead Road;
5. 177° 10' 155.2 feet along East side of Homestead Road;
6. 298° 35' 1334.6 feet along Lot 59 to a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
7. 59° 43' 62.0 feet along near West edge of Hokuwaikahe Gulch;
8. 38° 15' 244.9 feet along near West edge of Hokuwaikahe Gulch;
9. 8° 33' 125.7 feet along near West edge of Hokuwaikahe Gulch;
10. 118° 35' 1656.4 feet along Lot 57 to the point of beginning.
