Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 57, and on the East side of Ochiro Camp Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 1436.0 feet South and 219.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 204° 41' 676.9 feet along East side of Ochiro Camp Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 177° 40' 505.7 feet along East side of Ochiro Camp Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 311° 15' 679.8 feet along Lot 59 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 33° 35' 137.4 feet along top of the West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
5. 14° 33' 381.9 feet along top of the West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
6. 10° 07' 317.4 feet along top of the West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch;
7. 353° 00' 399.0 feet along top of the West edge of Kaiwilahilahi gulch to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
8. 131° 15' 790.0 feet along Lot 57 to the point of beginning.
