Beginning at a + on stone at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 59 and on the East side of homestead road, from which point the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Puhala Pipe" is $185^{\circ} 49'$ 1859.5 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalua-moa" are 1509.3 feet South and 1606.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2493, and running by true azimuths;-

1. $144^{\circ} 43'$ 747.7 feet along East side of homestead road to a + on stone;
2. $249^{\circ} 27'$ 1406.3 feet along Lot 57 to a + on stone;
3. $240^{\circ} 46' 30''$ 828.7 feet along Lot 57 to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalua-moa";
4. $328^{\circ} 12'$ 736.9 feet along Government land to an iron pipe;
5. $67^{\circ} 23'$ 360.3 feet along Lot 60; ~~taxaxpaxkax~~
6. $66^{\circ} 32'$ 1095.7 feet along Lots 60 and 59; ~~taxaxpaxkax~~
7. $65^{\circ} 00'$ 727.8 feet along Lot 59 to the point of beginning.
