Beginning at a + on stone at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 58 and on the East side of homestead road, from which point the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Puhala Pipe" is $185^{\circ} 49'$ 1859.5 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalua-moa" are 1509.3 feet South and 1606.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2493, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $245^{\circ} 00'$ 727.8 feet along Lot 58;
2. $246^{\circ} 32'$ 617.6 feet along Lot 58 to a + on stone;
3. $347^{\circ} 11' 30''$ 1039.7 feet along Lot 60 to a + on stone;
4. $86^{\circ} 25'$ 853.7 feet along Lot 62 to a + on stone;
5. $85^{\circ} 27'$ 986.8 feet along Lot 61 to a + on stone on the East side of homestead road;
6. $212^{\circ} 40'$ 703.5 feet along East side of homestead road to the point of beginning.
