5. 6° 24' 132.4 feet along the road to a + on stone;
6. 108° 02' 157.3 feet along the road to a + on stone;
7. 20° 03' 100.8 feet along the road to a + on stone;
8. 90° 00' 812.7 feet along Lot 58 to a + on stone;
9. 179° 19' 312.9 feet along the road to the point of beginning.
