Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot and the South corner of Lot 62, on the West side of Kalaniai Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalaniai" being 1570.5 feet South and 1934.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $360^{\circ} 00'$  770.7 feet along the West side of Kalaniai Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
2.  $90^{\circ} 00'$  130.0 feet along the North side of Kalaniai Road to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
3.  $125^{\circ} 00'$  1261.0 feet along Lot 58 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
4.  $215^{\circ} 00'$  705.9 feet along Lots 59 and 61 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
5.  $305^{\circ} 00'$  925.4 feet along Lot 62 to the point of beginning.
