Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 59, and on the East side of Papaaloa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 365.2 feet North and 203.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 205° 01' 451.0 feet along East side of Papaaloa Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 300° 40' 1148.5 feet along Grant 904 to Kapule and Nawahine to a galvanized iron pipe;
3. 60° 42' 186.8 feet along top of the West edge of Kawilahilahi gulch;
4. 36° 26' 140.1 feet along top of the West edge of Kawilahilahi gulch;
5. 33° 23' 331.1 feet along top of the West edge of Kawilahilahi gulch;
6. 131° 15' 998.6 feet along Lot 59 to the point of beginning.
