Beginning at a one inch galvanized iron pipe set in concrete at the North corner of this lot in middle of old stonewall and near West bank of the Waimea River, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Transit of Venus" being 13852.7 feet North and 291.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2599, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 334° 36' 284.4 feet along stonewall;
2. 352° 05' 171.1 feet along same;
3. 11° 48' 290.5 feet along same;
4. 33° 53' 152.7 feet along same;
5. 59° 57' 590.1 feet along fence to foot of pali;
6. 198° 27' 658.5 feet along foot of pali;
7. 218° 12' 408.5 feet along same;
8. 194° 35' 193.5 feet along same to the point of beginning.
