Beginning at a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 62, and on the East side of Papaaloa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 912.2 feet South and 816.8 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $223^{\circ} 14' 30''$ 1194.7 feet along East side of Papaaloa Road to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. $357^{\circ} 40'$ 774.1 feet along West side of Ochiro Camp Road to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. $24^{\circ} 41'$ 660.0 feet along West side of Ochiro Camp Road to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. $131^{\circ} 15'$ 762.7 feet along Lot 62 to the point of beginning.
