Beginning at a + on stone at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 65 and on the West side of homestead road, from which point the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Teton" is $96^{\circ} 05'$ 592.6 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaluamoa" are 3179.4 feet South and .2216 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2493, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $81^{\circ} 38' 30''$ 579.5 feet along Lot 65;
2. $93^{\circ} 44' 30''$ 557.1 feet along Lot 65 to a + on stone;
3. $180^{\circ} 13'$ 1204.1 feet along Lot 61 to a + on stone;
4. $266^{\circ} 25'$ 853.7 feet along Lot 59 to a + on stone;
5. $347^{\circ} 13'$ 1240.7 feet along Lot 60 and along West side of homestead road to the point of beginning.
