Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 64, and on the East side of Papaaloa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 1791.2 feet South and 1642.8 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 223° 14' 30" 539.7 feet along East side of Papaaloa Road to 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 311° 15' 1032.0 feet along Lot 62 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 13° 15' 499.8 feet along the West side of Ochiro Camp Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 63° 45' 106.3 feet along Ochiro Camp to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 131° 15' 1245.3 feet along Lot 64 to the point of beginning.

Area 14-58/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way (10 feet wide) for ditch across this lot, containing an area of 19/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 14-39/100 ACRES.
