Beginning at a + on stone at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 66 and on the East side of homestead road from which point the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Teton" is $94^{\circ} 37'$ 619.2 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalua-moa" are 3166.4 feet South and 150.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2493, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $167^{\circ} 13'$ 842.1 feet along East side of homestead road to a + on stone;
2. $238^{\circ} 08'$ 1268.1 feet along Lot 60 to an iron pipe;
3. $328^{\circ} 12'$ 969.8 feet along Government land to a + on stone;
4. $64^{\circ} 35'$ 1552.5 feet along Lot 66 to the point of beginning.
